SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR CATTLE ENTRIES

1. All exhibits must be penned by 9.30 am on Saturday, ready to be judged.
2. Exhibitors must arrange for either themselves or attendants to be available to present the cattle before the Judge.
3. Age of cattle to be the actual age at 1st March each year.
4. Entries to be registered with respective Breed Societies.
5. All entries in Stud Section must be led.
6. Bulls over the age of 12 months being paraded must have a nose ring.
7. Cattle entered in all classes must be TB and CAB free.
Also see special BJD rules (ID)
8. All ribbon winners must parade exhibits in the grand parade (if conducted).
9. Classes may be changed on the day of show at the discretion of Stewards.
10. The Cooma Showground is a protected Bovine Johnes area and any breeder wanting to exhibit from a lower status area must blood test their show team within 6 months of the current show, if they are 2 years or older, or if under 2 years their dam must be blood tested. If cattle come from a herd in the Johnes MAP a copy of current certificate must be forwarded with entries. Herd health declaration forms will be forwarded to previous Exhibitors.
11. Calves under six (6) months enter at own risk.
12. **NLIS:** All cattle brought onto the show grounds must be identified with an **NLIS device** before leaving their property.
13. No cattle will be permitted to leave the showground before 3.30pm unless with the express permission of the head steward.
