SECTION BY LAWS

1. Stud breeders are not permitted to enter commercial breeder classes (section 6).
2. Fleeces must not have more than 12 months growth.
3. Fleeces must be skirted (Insufficiently skirted fleeces will have the excess removed by the stewards before judging).
4. All fleeces will be OFDA tested and placed in their appropriate micron classes.

Extra Ultrafine	<16.1	Fine Medium	19.6-20.5

5. Where there are insufficient fleeces within a micron class, some micron classes may be combined at the wool stewards discretion.
6. All fleeces will be examined prior to judging, any fleece considered to be entered in the wrong section will be transferred to the appropriate section.
7. All exhibitors are requested to include precise instructions as to the desired method of collection of their fleeces at the conclusion of the show. Instructions are to be given in the space provided on this form.
8. Junior classified according to RAS regulations as 25 years and under (on the day of the show).
9. Fleeces will be Judged on the points allocated in the Judging system of the National Council of Wool Brokers of Australia, and may incorporate some R.A.S. benchmarks & calculations.
10. **As per the regulations for pavilion exhibits, an entry fee (per Fleece) will be payable upon entry (which accompany this form). Unpaid entry's will not be exhibited.**
11. One entry form per exhibitor (including Junior exhibitors) must be completed upon entry.
12. Individual fleeces are to be entered in one class only.
13. A maximum of three fleeces per exhibitor is allowed in the one micron class, within a section. Where more than three fleeces are entered, the wool steward will choose which fleeces to exhibit. (Depending on class size & available space the steward may choose to show all entries).
14. Fleeces are to be delivered in a plastic bag and are to be clearly labelled with the exhibitors name.
15. **Entry's are to be delivered no later than the Wednesday, prior to the day of Show.**
16. Entry's can be delivered to Jemalong Wool & Monaro Wool Services at any time, in the weeks leading up to the show. Or can be delivered to the pavilion on Wednesday.
17. Fleeces will be available for collection on Saturday from 6 pm and will also be available for collection from Jemalong Wool from 8:00am on Monday morning.
18. Junior fleece judging will be held in conjunction with Junior sheep Judging (see the Junior Judging page, in the show schedule for more details).
19. 1st, 2nd & 3rd places will be awarded in each class. For exceptions, see point 5, above.
