BY-LAWS FOR ANGORA GOAT ENTRIES

1. Angoras entered for judging must be penned by 9.30 am to be Judged by 10.00 am on **Saturday 10 March 2012.**
2. All stud entries must have clearly visible ear tattoos.
3. **Every Exhibitor MUST complete owner declaration on entry form, Johne's Disease Regulation Form and have a PIC number.**
An Angora steward must initial this form before unloading Angoras at the show.
4. **All animals entering the show MUST have NLIS tags in ears and complete an animal health statement and a National Vendor Declaration or Traveling Health Statement.**
5. All animals shown must have been bred on the property and in possession of the Exhibitor or a member of the household at least **three (3) months** prior to the show.
6. If, in the opinion of the stewards, an exhibit is improperly classed, it may be moved to a more appropriate class.
Objections by Exhibitor may lead to disqualification.
7. The association accepts no responsibility to or by any exhibit.

BY-LAWS FOR CASHMERE GOAT ENTRIES

1. Goats must be penned by 9.00am on day of show.
2. All cashmere goats must be inspected by the stewards for lice and foot problems prior to penning. Any animals with either problem to be removed from the cashmere pavilion immediately.
3. All entries must comply with animal health regulations as required by ASC.
4. **All animals entering the show MUST have NLIS tags in ears and complete an animal health statement and a National Vendor Declaration or Traveling Health Statement..**
5. All cashmere goats must have clearly visible and identifiable ear tags.
6. Exhibitors are restricted to two entries per class.
7. Every Exhibitor must complete a Johne's Disease Declaration Form.
8. Entries close 2 March 2012.

BY-LAWS FOR FLEECE ENTRIES

50c per exhibit

1. All fleeces to be unskirted
2. Only prize-winning fleeces will be displayed at the Show Pavilion. Pavilion exhibits cannot be removed from the Pavilion prior to 6.00pm on Saturday 10 March 2012 unless arranged with Head Steward.
3. All fleeces must be packed in separate white bags with name of Exhibitor clearly written on each bag, plus class entry, name or number of animal and fleece weight.
Fleeces to be delivered to pavilion at 9.00am the day before the show.
4. Entries close 2 March 2012.
