BY-LAWS

1. All Subsections will be Judged on Saturday 10 March 2012.
2. Judging of subsection B2 will commence 9.00 am. Sheep in subsections B1 and B4 must be in readiness to be Judged at 9.30am.
3. Brucellosis Accreditation Certificate to be produced on arrival.
4. All Stud Merino Sheep entered in Classes 1 to 49 must be shorn in accordance with NSW Sheep Breeders Rules and carry the Association's ear labels for the current year.
5. Sheep may be entered for one class only except where otherwise stated.
6. Every Exhibitor must fill in a Footrot Status Form and Johne's Disease Form. A Sheep Steward must initial this form before unloading of sheep at the show.
Appropriate veterinary inspection certificate accepted.
7. Awarding of ribbons are at the Judges discretion.
8. In Commercial Merino Sheep, classes can be combined by the Head Steward if insufficient entries are received.
9. All Sheep to be bred by Exhibitor and showing appropriate tags.
10. **All sheep entering the show MUST have NLIS tags in ears and complete an Animal Health Statement.**
11. **ENTRY FEES:**

Subsection 3 \$NIL fee.
Subsection 4 \$2 per entry.

28. **THE MANDERLEY TROPHY** - donated by Manderley Past. Co. for a pen of three Merino ewes, any age, bred by the Exhibitor and from the one stud. To be selected from the exhibits in general classes. To be Judged with due regard to type and uniformity necessary in breeding. To be competed for annually. Exhibitor's name will be inscribed on the trophy. First, second and third placings to be awarded.
