## SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR VEGETABLES

1. All exhibits to be delivered Thursday 8th March 2012 between 6.30pm and 9pm or by 9.00am on Friday 9th March 2012
2. Judging to start at 10am on Friday 9th March 2012
3. All exhibits must have been grown by Exhibitor or a member of his or her household.
4. Junior is Exhibitor under 17 years of age.
5. STANDARD UNIT A standard unit for any particular vegetable is shown in vegetables classes eg 3 carrots, 12 beans, 1 long cucumber, 3 apple cucumbers.
6. AOV = Any other variety.

## GENERAL HINTS ON EXHIBITING VEGETABLES

Vegetables must be true to type. A variety may have several types but entry shall be all of the same type. The size, shape and colour should be identical.

TOPS. Vegetables such as carrots should be shown with the tops cut back leaving about 75 -100 mm of the top on. This should be fresh, without wilting or other damage.
