- All exhibits to be delivered on Thursday evening, March 7, 2019 between 6:30pm and 9.00pm or between 7.30am and 9.30am on Friday, March 8, 2019.
- 2. Judging to start at 10.00am on Friday, March 8, 2019.
- All exhibits must have been grown by the exhibitor or a member of his or her household.
- 4. Junior is an exhibitor 17 years of age and under.
- 5. STANDARD UNIT: A standard unit for any particular vegetable is shown in vegetable classes eg:
 - 3 carrots, 12 beans, 1 long cucumber, 3 apple cucumbers.
- 6. AOV: Any other variety.
- 7. Entries can be collected from 6.00pm on day of show, ie Saturday, March 9, 2019. Entries and prizemoney not collected will be forfeited.

GENERAL HINTS ON EXHIBITING VEGETABLES

Vegetables must be true to type. A variety may have several types but entry shall be all of the same type. The size, shape and colour should be identical.

TOPS: Vegetables such as carrots should be shown with the tops cut back leaving about 75 -100mm of the top on. This should be fresh, without wilting or other damage.
