- 1. Entry forms: Must be submitted by Friday March 3 2023. NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.** Entry forms can be completed online at [www.coomashow.com.au](http://www.coomashow.com.au) or delivered to the Cooma Showground Multifunction Centre between 10:00am and 2:00pm on Friday March 3, 2023 or posted to PO Box 809, Cooma NSW 2630.
- 2. All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 8 March 2023 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
- 3. Entries can be collected from 6pm onwards on day of show, Saturday, March 11 2023. Entries and/or prize money not collected on this day will be forfeited.**
- 4. Name and age must be on back of entries**
- 5. Exhibitors may enter both the poetry and short stories sections**
- 6. Published authors and poets are not eligible to enter**
