1. **Entry forms** must be submitted by **Friday February 28 2025** and can be completed online at www.coomashow.com.au **or** delivered to Cooma Visitors Centre between February 1 2025 and February 28 2025 7 days week 9am to 3pm. **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.**
2. **All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 5 March 2025 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
3. **Entries can be collected from 6pm onwards on day of show Saturday March 8 2025. Entries and/or prize money not collected on this day will be forfeited.**
4. Name and Contact number must be supplied.
5. Style of beer must be stated. Whether kit or recipe must be stated. Date and ABV preferred.
6. Whether alcoholic or non alcoholic must be stated for Cider and Ginger Beer classes. Fruit Wine, Liqueur and Spirit classes must have variety stated.
7. Winners of classes 1-5 will be eligible to enter Group 6 Home Brew Beer Competition at Dalgety Show in 2026.
