**COLOURED SHEEP**

**ENTRY FEE:** \$2 per exhibit

**PRIZES:** Certificates, ribbons and sponsor prizes

**Special By-Laws for Coloured Sheep entries:**

1. All classes will be judged on Saturday March 14 2026 and must be at the showground by 9am.
  2. **Classes may be adjusted or combined as required**
  3. Brucellosis Accreditation Certificate to be produced on arrival.
  4. Every exhibitor must complete a Footrot Status form and Johnes Disease form. A sheep steward must initial this form before sheep can be unloaded at the show.
  5. All sheep to be owned by exhibitor for at least six (6) months and show appropriate tags
  6. **All sheep entering the show MUST have *Electronic* NLIS tags as per DPI requirements for 2026. An Animal Health Statement must be completed for each entry.**
  7. **Awards: Aggregate points:** Classes 1 through 12 and Champion and Reserve sheep are eligible for aggregate points towards the trophy. Convenors may delete classes but not add new classes to be eligible for the trophy. Wether classes are able to be added, however, are only eligible for Champion Wether and no points towards the trophy.
- Points System:** In all classes, regardless of the number of entries the following points are awarded: 1<sup>st</sup> – 5pts; 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3pts; 3<sup>rd</sup> – 1pt Champion – 5pts; Reserve – 3pts

## COLOURED FLEECE

**ENTRY FEE:** \$2 per exhibit

**PRIZES:** Certificates, ribbons and sponsor prizes

### SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR WOOL ENTRIES

1. Fleeces must not have more than 12 months' growth.
2. Fleeces must be skirted (insufficiently skirted fleeces will have the excess removed by the stewards before judging).
3. All fleeces will be examined prior to judging, any fleece considered to be entered in the wrong section will be transferred to the appropriate section.
4. One entry form per exhibitor (including junior exhibitors) must be completed upon entry.
5. Individual fleeces are to be entered in one class only.
6. Fleeces are to be delivered in a plastic bag, clearly labelled with the exhibitor's name.
7. Entries are to be delivered no later than **9:00am Friday March 13 2026 prior to the Cooma Show on March 14 2026.**
8. Fleeces will be available for collection on show day from 6:00pm.

### 9. Awards:

**Aggregate points:** Classes 1 through 8 and Champion and Reserve sheep are eligible for aggregate points towards the trophy. Head Stewards may delete classes but not add new classes to be eligible for the trophy.

**Points System:** In all classes, regardless of the number of entries the following points are awarded: 1st – 5pts; 2nd – 3pts; 3rd – 1pt Champion – 5pts; Reserve – 3pts
