Entry forms must be completed by **Friday March 6 2026 (NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED OR JUDGED)** and can be completed online at [www.coomashow.com.au](http://www.coomashow.com.au) **or** delivered to Cooma Visitors Centre between February 1 2026 and March 6 2026, 7 days a week between 9am to 3pm.
2. **All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 11 March 2026 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
3. Exhibits may have been washed or used; however, they must not be soiled and must be of acceptable standard (at the discretion of the stewards and judges).
4. Exhibits may be entered in a maximum of two (2) sections.
5. All articles to have been completed in the last 12 months.
6. Due to space restraints Cooma P&A Association reserves the right not to hang all quilts.
