SPECIAL BY-LAWS FOR FIBRECRAFT ENTRIES

1. Entry forms must be completed by **Friday March 5 2027 (NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED OR JUDGED)** and can be completed online at www.coomashow.com.au or delivered to Cooma Visitors Centre between February 1 2027 and March 5 2027, 7 days a week between 9am to 3pm.
2. **All exhibits must be delivered to the multi-function centre on Wednesday 10 March 2027 between 8:00am and 6:00pm.**
3. Each exhibit must be the work of the exhibitor.
4. Exhibits may have been washed or used; however, they must not be soiled and must be of acceptable standard (at the discretion of the stewards and judges).
5. Exhibits may be lightly pressed and is recommended.
6. Any yarn is permissible except where otherwise stated.
7. **ENTRIES can be collected from 6.00pm and 6:30pm on day of show, Saturday March 13 2027. Entries and/or any prizes not collected will be forfeited.**

KNITTING

1. STRANDED COLOUR WORK/ SCOTTISH FAIR ISLE ARTICLE where 2 colours of yarn are worked on the same row with one colour carried at the back of the work
2. CABLE ARTICLE
3. BABY'S ARTICLE, any other
4. CHILD'S ARTICLE
5. TOYS or DOLLS ARTICLE
6. ANY OTHER KNITTING
 - a) Small Items – i.e. hats, scarves
 - b) Large Items – i.e. knee rugs, bed cover

CROCHET

7. TABLEWARE ARTICLE
8. BABY'S ARTICLE, any other
9. CHILD'S ARTICLE
10. TOYS or DOLLS ARTICLE
11. ANY OTHER CROCHETING
 - a) Small Items – i.e. hats, scarves
 - b) Large Items – i.e. knee rugs, bed cover

SPINNING

A staple of original fibre, washed, plied and skeined, to be attached to each entry, not less than 50g.

12. HANDSPUN ANY FIBRE

13. HANDSPUN MERINO FIBRE direct from fleece, washed and prepared by exhibitor

HANDSPUN FIBRE ARTICLE

Each article to be crafted by exhibitor and a staple of original fibre to be attached to each entry.

14. KNITTED or CROCHETED ARTICLE – using handspun fibre

15. ANY ARTICLE

WEAVING

16. ANY ARTICLE

JUNIORS – 12 years and under. Please include age of exhibitor on entry form

17. ANY ARTICLE

YOUTH – 17 years and under. Please include age of exhibitor on entry form

18. ANY ARTICLE

NOVICE

Exhibitor must not have won a prize at any show

19. ANY ARTICLE IN FIBRECRAFT

SENIOR – 65 years and over

20. ANY ARTICLE IN FIBRECRAFT

a) Small Items – i.e. hats, scarves

b) Large Items – i.e. knee rugs, bed cover

FUNDS FROM FIBRECRAFT – Community Chest

21. ANY ANIMAL knitted or crocheted toy
